School News

- The school has been busy over the last 6 weeks even with the emergent alternate teaching that has been going on.
- Last day for instruction is June 19th for all students in EIPS

- 22 thru 24 of June we are ask families that were lent out school materials such as Chromebooks, library books or other classroom materials, please return these items to the school during these three days.
- June 22 to the 29th teachers are in the school finishing up the year and preparing for the fall.
- Report cards will be released electronically at 3 pm on June 26th and will be accessible from EIPS parents' portal.

Budget: (as of May 26, 2020)

- Well it is going to be a very challenging year coming up with lots of change and movement within the school and the district. We have about 21 fewer students and the funding reductions from the UCP works out to about \$257,000 less.
- The special education funding has 4 levels, level 1 and 2 are now being funded at zero, Level 3 is \$13,000 (14) and level 4 is at \$41,000 (1).
- Assistant principal and counseling assignments have also been defined in the district so for us this means both will be teaching in a classroom half time.
- Standardized timetable for all elementary schools has also been implemented throughout the district. 10 -32 min blocks for regular day and 10- 26 Min blocks on early dismissal days.
- EIPS guideline class size K=24, 1-3=26, 4-6=28
- Reduction in 4 certificated (Teachers), 2 classified (Educational Assistance) staff from the 2019-2020 school year.
