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5. Principal's Report – Judy Anderson

- a) Brightspace – Professional Learning Day for teachers on communication and posting content for students using Brightspace. Lead Tech teachers, Ms. Barry and Ms. Halcrow spent the day team teaching in classrooms to help students all log in to Brightspace and explore the platform. Teachers have weekly tutorials to continue our professional growth with Brightspace.
- b) Additional funding from Federal Government – additional EA time, FTE towards targeted numeracy/literacy supports including LLI, Sub Days for lead teachers to do numeracy benchmarking and instructional support with LLI
- c) Team Meetings – Every 8 weeks, meet in grade level teams to review STAR data & teacher anecdotal notes to guide instructional planning and targeted supports for students. More leveled literacy intervention (LLI) and numeracy targeted support started with additional funding.
- d) Remembrance Day Ceremony – committee working to create a video ceremony that will be shown in all classrooms on Friday, November 6 at 10:45 a.m. We have students involved including a poem with Mrs. Lastiwka and Mrs. Delainey's Grade 1 class, a song with Mrs. Miles da Silva's Grade 4 class, Mrs. Botterill's Grade 5 class singing O Canada, some Grade 3 students laying wreaths, and two Grade 6 MCs.

Programs Vice-Chair Updates – Sheila Connolly

Budget Vice-Chair Updates – Erin Barrett

- a. Vote on final 2019/20 budget

Motion: Ryan made motion to approve 2019/2020 financial statement as presented. Seconded by Jenn. Motion carried.

- b. Vote on proposed 2020/21 budget

Motion: Jenn made motion to approve 2020/2021 budget with the option to amend. Erin seconded. Motion carried.

- c. Vote on 20/21 disbursement requests from Glen Allan Elementary

Motion: Jenn made motion to approve the disbursement request of \$5,980.0 to GLN for the 2020/2021 year. Erin seconded. Motion carried.

- d. Discussion on account reserve recommendation

- Reserves kept higher to be able to pay for disbursements early in the school year, prior to fundraising for that school year.
- Ryan – lower reserves gradually (over a couple years)
- Jessica – suggest no major changes in current year given current uncertainty.
- Judy to discuss other options for GLN with staff for potential additional disbursements.

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- e. Update on financial procedures document - draft discussed
 - i. Only council executive to pay out of pocket with approval of treasurer - prior to purchase
 - ii. Volunteers – sign document to acknowledge that they received money from treasurer and would provide receipts
 - Pre-shop prior to receiving funds
 - iii. Petty cash float managed by Ryan
 - Erin to present finalized procedures at the November meeting
