## 5. EIPS Trustee Report – Don Irwin

- September 26, 2019 Board Highlights
- September 30 Enrolment- 17,400 students currently enrolled in EIPS. This is up from 17,150 last year. EIPS is the 6th largest district in Alberta with 43 schools.
- Council of School Councils (COSC) The first COSC meeting was held on October 2. Parents from school councils are welcome to attend this meeting which provides information and resources to school councils and parents. - Provincial Achievement Testing Results Students from EIPS performed above Provincial Averages in almost all categories.
- In November, schools report their previous years' results including School plans, PAT results and detailed school information.
