School Goals:


GOAL 1: Glen Allan School will enhance student engagement and achievement by focusing on research based effective teaching practices and its implementation throughout the school.

At Glen Allan we will be focusing our efforts for Bullying Awareness week around the positive behaviors we want to promote in our students. In our main hallway we are creating a bulletin board where each student will add a word to represent how they would like to be described or



remembered as a person. Throughout Bullying Awareness week will be using the kindness game on daily announcements and in classrooms. All staff will also continue to promote our philosophy that "Glen Allan is a school of dignity and respect, so walk the talk and practice what you preach". This will also be reinforced as discipline issues arise at the school and we will also incorporate it into our catching students doing the right thing positive behavior program. Wednesday, we are doing a school wide writing activity where students will write and share about their personal heroes. Thursday will focus on the quote "Be the change you want to see in the world" by Gandhi and Friday we are having a "Put a cap on bullying" day where the students will wear hats to show their support.

- d. Strathcona Christmas Bureau
 - We will be participating in the Strathcona Christmas Bureau's 41st campaign. We are collecting donations of non-perishable food, new unwrapped toys and other gifts, and/or financial assistance for the 2017 campaign. We will be participating from November 20 to December 8. There will be a Christmas tree in the front entrance of the school for item drop off.
