    - Looking into Healthy Hunger as an option; Adrienne Suelzle runs Hot Lunch website and orders, mentioned current site and set-up is economically viable; Healthy Hunger is free to use so it could be trialed before moving over; Hot Lunch paid for this year; volunteers always needed; suggestions for vendors
